- The library assumes no responsibility for the quality, accuracy, timeliness or content of any Internet resource.
- The Internet may contain materials of a controversial and/or offensive nature.
- **Parents or guardians, not the library staff, are expected to monitor and supervise their children's use of the Internet in accordance with library rules and policies.**
- Two 60 minutes sessions per day.
- Staff assistance may not always be available. Staff can provide only limited assistance for basic start-up procedures. Patrons will be expected to have basic computer skills.
- Users may **not** save data on the computer's hard drive or alter the computer's hardware or software in any manner. Patrons may bring in their own flash drives to be used for downloading.
- 20¢ a page will be charged for any printing done on the library's printers. All printing is black and white, no color printing is available at this time.
- Computers will be turned off one half hour before closing.
- Computer resources may only be used for legal purposes. Unacceptable purposes include, but are not limited to,
  - destruction of or damage to equipment, software, or data belonging to the library or other users;
  - violation of system security;
  - commercial transactions;
  - **intentionally sending, receiving, or displaying text or graphics which may reasonably be construed as obscene, pornographic, harmful, or disruptive. Punitive measures may be taken.**
